What is COMBOGESIC®?

COMBOGESIC® (acetaminophen and ibuprofen) is the first combination analgesic which provides double action of two well-known and effective medicines, acetaminophen and ibuprofen, in a single tablet.¹

COMBOGESIC® contains 325 mg of acetaminophen and 97.5 mg of ibuprofen.¹ This 3.3:1 ratio has been clinically proven to provide fast and effective pain relief.



What is COMBOGESIC® used for?

COMBOGESIC® is indicated for:¹

- Short term management of mild to moderate acute pain
- Reduction of fever

For adults over 18 years old.

How does COMBOGESIC® work?

Acetaminophen works to stop the pain messages from getting through to the brain. It also acts in the brain to reduce fever. Ibuprofen is a non-steroidal anti-inflammatory medicine. It relieves pain and reduces inflammation.

How is COMBOGESIC® used?

The recommended adult dose of COMBOGESIC® is 1-2 tablets every 6 hours. If pain or fever does not respond to 2 tablets, 3 tablets may be taken at subsequent doses, but only on the advice of a physician. Do not exceed 12 tablets over a 24-hour period.¹

COMBOGESIC® tablets should not be taken for fever for more than three days or for pain for more than five days unless recommended by a physician. COMBOGESIC® tablets should not be taken with other acetaminophen or ibuprofen containing products.¹
